

What is it?

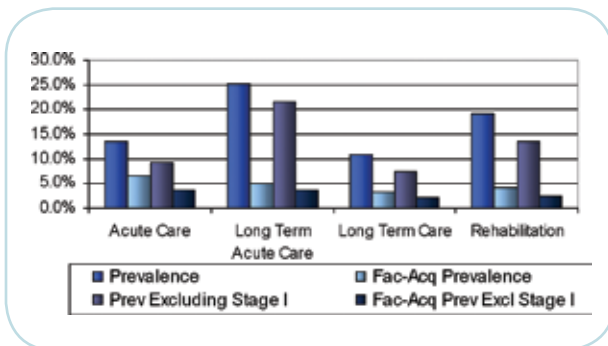
